English

This half term, we are focusing our writing skills on the text 'Tidy' by Emily Gravett. The children will be reading and writing about the text. The written outcome at the end of the unit will be a leaflet explaining how to keep our school tidy. If you have any leaflets about anything at home, please send them into school.

Reading Challenge




The children are getting on well with our reading challenge, so please continue to write the number of minutes that your child has read each night in their yellow reading record.



Mathematics

This half term, the children will be focusing on fractions and time. At home, ask your child about their learning and encourage them to practice the skills they have learnt in class.



The children will continue to learn about plants. They will be learning about materials and will identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials for particular uses. Mr. Sanson will continue to teach the Science curriculum in Year 2. If you have any spare pots for planting, please bring them in. (Big or small)





PE will be on a Monday and Tuesday for both year 2 classes.



History

In history, the children will be learning about the Liberation of Jersey and what life was like for the people of Jersey living in an occupied island during World War II.



PSHE-Relationships

In JIGSAW the children will discuss and identify the different members of their family, understand their relationship with each of them and know why it is important to share and cooperate with them. They will learn that there are lots of forms of physical contact within a family and discuss which types of physical contact they like and don't like. They will discuss and identify some of the things that can cause conflict with their friends and learn how to use positive problem-solving technique to resolve conflicts with them.

D.T.

The children will be exploring and developing sliding mechanisms. They will learn what a pivot, lever and wheel mechanism do and evaluate their work identifying areas for future development.
