

## Nursery Autumn 2 Curriculum Letter

Dear Parents and Guardians

We have thoroughly enjoyed welcoming your children back to school and amazed by the ability to adapt back into routines and expectations.

Outlined below is the learning that we plan to share with the children this term.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will also take part in weekly Jigsaw sessions. This term our theme is Being Me in My World which covers:

- I am learning what being responsible means.
- I know how it feels to be proud of something I am good at.
- I know we are all different but the same in some ways. / I know that all families are different.
- I know there are lots of different houses and homes.
- I can tell you how I could make new friends.
- I can use my words to stand up for myself.



### Physical Development

This term we will provide opportunities for children:

- To go up steps and stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet.
- To continue to develop movement skills such as, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes, and bikes) and ball skills.



### Communication and Language

Speech and Language is a prime area of our curriculum. This term we will be providing opportunities for the children to:

- To continue enjoying listening to longer stories and remembering much of what happens
- To pay attention to more than one thing at a time, which can be difficult.
- To understand a question or instruction that has two parts, such as: "Get your coat and wait at the door".



### Literacy

To support literacy development this term we will be supporting the children in beginning to understand some of the five concepts of print:

- To understand the names of the different parts of a book.
- page sequencing



### Mathematics

Through stories, singing and interactions we will be teaching and encouraging children:

- To develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects.
- To compare quantities using language: 'more than,' 'fewer than'
- To talk about and identify the patterns around them.



### Understanding the World

Children learn to make sense of the world through their exploration, investigation, and play. This term we are helping the children:

- To begin to make sense of their own life-story and family's history.



- To talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary.
- To explore collections of materials with similar and/or different properties.

### Expressive Arts and Design

At Samares we encourage the children's imaginations and creations. This term children will learn:



- To listen with increased attention to sounds.
- To develop our own ideas and then decide which materials to use to express them.
- To take part in simple pretend play, using an object to represent something else even though they are not similar.

### Birthdays

If bringing any treats to school, they must be store bought, unfortunately we cannot provide children with homemade goods due to risk of allergy.

### Tapestry
