

Learning in Reception



Welcome back, it's hard to believe that we are now halfway through Reception!

Literacy

We are continuing to consolidate our Phonics learning with a particular focus on blending as this is an essential step for children to be able to read and decode words. We will also continue to work hard at letter formation, using our knowledge to help us write short words and phrases.

Topic

This half term, we are learning about the past through significant people and events. We will learn about the Moon landing and some important astronauts. Children will be exploring a variety of texts to support their learning. We will also continue to focus on celebrations as we learn about Mother's Day and Easter.



Maths

During Maths lessons, we are learning about addition, learning to recognise the symbols + and =. We will also be looking at number bonds to make different amounts. This will help develop a deep understanding of numbers to 10. Children are now expected to begin to form their numbers correctly.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will be focusing on Healthy Me! We will be exploring topics such as sport and exercise, healthy eating and sleep. We also continue to learn about the Zones of Regulation which helps us to recognise and name our emotions.
