



Dear parents and carers,

Welcome back to the second half of the term. The children have settled and adapted well to the changes and routines that have been introduced in Year 2. We hope that everyone is ready for the very busy half term ahead!

#### English

This half term, we are focusing our writing based on the text 'The Dragon Machine' by Helen Ward. The children will be reading and writing about the text and creating their own narrative based on the story. Their new learning for this piece of writing will be how to use **past tense** verbs.



The children will continue to access the daily Read Write Inc. programme in groups. In order to continue to develop their reading skills, it is really important to **read at home** regularly.

The children will have mixture of spelling patterns and the Year 2 common exception words to learn at home each week. Spellings will be tested every **Monday** and the new list will be sent home the same day. Please ensure that their **homework books or folders** are in their book bags every **Monday**.

#### Mathematics

This half term, the children will focus on multiplication and division, and measurement. At home, you can encourage your child to practice their skills by asking them to show you the methods they have been learning in class.

#### Science

The children will be learning about the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene. They will find out how to eat a healthy, balanced diet and why exercise is important to keep their bodies healthy.

#### PE



PE will take place on a **Friday** with Mrs. Boyle. This half term the children will be developing simple tactics for attacking and defending. They will be learning about Netball and playing mini games. They will develop teamwork skills and master basic attacking and defending tactics.

#### Computing



Creating Media- Digital photography- The children will find out about the range of devices that they can use to take photographs, develop their skills in the composition of taking quality photographs and how to edit their images.

#### Voice 21



Oracy enables children to learn to talk and learn through talk - it helps to consolidate learning, build and challenge on the ideas of others as well as their own, and helps children become articulate and effective communicators. The Year 2 Oracy target this term is **to use sentence stems to help their understanding** in Maths.

## Geography



In geography the children will be learning about the continents and oceans in relation to **Africa (Kenya)** and about where Jersey is in relation to the rest of the world. They will be using atlases, learning about the environment, the people and the varied wildlife of **Kenya**. They will learn to make some comparisons between **Kenya** and **Jersey**.



## PSHE

This half term the class are learning about **Celebrating Difference** through focusing on the importance of valuing and respecting themselves and others. Children will start to recognise and appreciate differences among themselves and others by understanding what makes them special and unique. Children will learn to accept everyone's right to 'difference' and explore the concept of 'normal' and bullying – what it is and what it isn't.



## Art

Composition & Tone– The children will continue to learn about the artist **Caravaggio** and the use of light and shade in his work. They will learn to use a range of pencil gradients and make accurate representations of real objects and scenes that they have carefully observed. They will create some tonal drawings and learn some subject specific terminology, such as: **focal point, rule of thirds, composition, tonal range, highlight, shadow** and **depth**. They will learn how to use sketchbooks to record observations, review and revisit ideas and evaluate their artwork.



## Music

Mrs Le Brun will be focusing on teaching the children some traditional Christmas songs this half term. Mrs King will continue to teach the children a range of instruments in readiness for their performances on **Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December**.



## Homework
