

RE: Autumn 1 2025

Welcome back! I hope you had a lovely summer holiday. I am really looking forward to this half term and below I have outlined the learning that will take place.

Maths

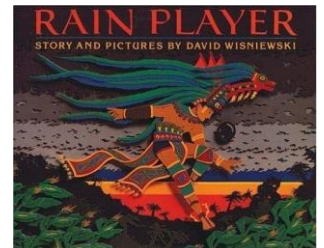


Year 6 will be starting off the Autumn Term looking at number and place value which includes rounding, ordering numbers and working with negative numbers. We will also be reviewing addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Your support with helping children learn their times tables facts and continuing with mental maths questions linked to these are greatly appreciated. Online games or apps (such as hit the button) or websites (BBC bitesize) would be helpful for fluency and recapping learning.

Literacy

During the first part of the half term, we will be using the book 'Rain Player' as a stimulus for our writing. We will use ideas from this book and facts about the Maya people to write instructions, diaries and newspaper articles.

Please encourage your child to read every evening as this will benefit all of their literacy skills.



History

This term, history will be taught by Mr Bolton. Children will learn who the ancient Maya people were, and where and when they lived. We will use maps and atlases to locate Maya cities and identify countries in Mesoamerica. In addition to this, we will learn about the religious beliefs and rituals of the Maya and find out more about some of the many gods they worshipped. The children will also learn about the Maya number system and have the opportunity to read and write Maya numbers and solve number problems.



RE

This term, RE will be taught by Mr Bolton. Children will be investigating the different versions of the creation story. We will explain their own views and explore the beliefs of others. We will also learn about the Maya creation story.





Science

Our science topic this half term is 'Animals including Humans.' Children will be learning about the circulatory and digestive systems. We will also learn about what our body needs for nourishment. Children will have the chance to take part in a live video call with a paediatric cardiologist who works in a London hospital, as well as dissect a pig's heart!

PE

6B will have PE on **Tuesdays** and **Wednesdays** with Mrs Boyle.

Please ensure children have the correct school PE kit, including a PE jacket for lessons outside, and appropriate trainers or plimsolls.

Homework

Year 6 will receive weekly homework which will include:

- Maths fluency
- Spellings (Year 6 Jersey Curriculum)

Homework will be given out on a **Monday** and collected in the following **Monday**.

There is a homework tray in the classroom for children to put their homework in and they are welcome to give it in earlier in the week. If your child loses their homework, there is a tray in the classroom with spare copies.

Please encourage your child to take responsibility for their own learning in preparation for secondary school.
