ABOUT THE COURSE

This **6-week course** aims to improve parents' and carers' knowledge of ADHD and how it affects their child. Meet other parents and learn ways to:

- **accept and celebrate** your child as they are
- support your child and **build their skills**
- **reduce your stress** as a parent
- **manage difficulties**

To better meet the needs of different age groups, we now offer NFPP as two separate courses, under 12's and 12 - 16. This allows the teen course to also focus on:

- understanding how **neurological and physiological changes in adolescence** interact with ADHD behaviours

EARLYBIRD 0-6 AND EARLYBIRD PLUS 5-10

The National Autistic Society's EarlyBird is a **6-week** post-diagnostic support programme.

During the course, you will learn more about autism following your child's diagnosis.

- develop **basic play** and **social skills**
- improve communication and **support interactions**
- **understand and support** your child's behaviour
