

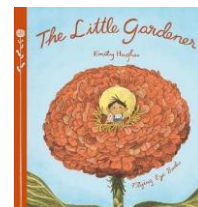
Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you have all had a lovely Easter break and that your child is glad to be back at school. We are looking forward to a busy half term of learning. Here is a newsletter to update you on what is coming up this half term.



Literacy

In Literacy pupils are learning through a book called 'The Little Gardener', which is about a boy who must work very hard to keep his garden alive and well. However, no matter how hard he works, he is too little to look after the garden by himself. We will be working towards writing a letter to the Little Gardener about how we can help him and his garden. Our main objective is to begin to punctuate sentences using question marks and using the suffix -ing.



During the daily Read, Write, Inc. sessions, children are in groups to help them master and develop their reading skills at their own pace. The children are making good progress. Please make sure your child continues to read their books at home and return them when necessary. They can change them every day if needed!

Mathematics

This term pupils will be learning about time, money, and place value to 100.

All the way through our maths learning we will be applying our learning to solve real life problems. When possible, you could practise with your child their counting, number bonds, and addition and subtraction to help develop their fluency. Please also practice telling the time to the nearest o'clock and half past and recognising coins and using money.



Science



As scientists, the pupils will be learning about plants. They will be learning how to identify wild and garden plants, and deciduous and evergreen trees as well as knowing the parts of a plant.

DT

In DT we will be designing and creating our own plant pots. We will explore different materials and techniques, carefully planning our designs before constructing and decorating the final product.

PSHE / JIGSAW

This half term JIGSAW is focusing on 'Relationships'. The children will be focusing on making friends, people who help us, and our families.
