



# Year 2 Curriculum Newsletter

## Summer Term 2 2026

Dear parents and carers,

Welcome to the final term of year 2! The children have packed in so much learning this year already and we look forward to seeing them continue to do so in their final weeks of Key Stage 1.

### English

This half term, we are focusing our writing skills on the story 'The Journey Home' by Frann Preston-Gannon. The children will be reading and writing about the text and learning to use the past tense and the spelling rules linked to this in their writing. The written outcome at the end of the unit will be a postcard from the polar bear to his family at home.



### Reading



Please ensure that your child has their plastic reading folder with them in class every day. There are opportunities for the children to change their books each day either in class or in their RWI group.

### Mathematics

This half term, the children will be revisiting Multiplication, Division, Fractions and Time. They will also be reviewing multiplication and division facts of the 2x, 5x and 10x tables. Please encourage your child to practice the skills they have learnt in class at home.



### Science

The children will continue their learning about materials. They will continue their Plant topic including growing and looking after class plants.



### PE

Class 2D have PE on Monday and Thursday, class 2OD have PE on Tuesday and Thursday, Both classes are doing multi-sports with Mrs Boyle.

## R.E.



The key question for this half term is 'Why are some places sacred to believers?'. This will involve learning about different holy places, the use of some sacred objects, and the similarities and differences across multiple religions.



## Geography

This term's learning focuses on taking detailed weather measurements, examining a coastal environment close to school and comparing the physical and human geographical features of Jersey and France. This will include creating a fact file for France as well as an in-depth study on the country's capital; Paris.



## PSHE- Changing Me

In JIGSAW, the children will learn about cycles of life in nature. They will learn about the natural process of growing from young to old and given opportunities to understand that this is not in their control. They will also learn to recognise how their body has changed since they were a baby. At the end of the unit we will discuss what they are looking forward to when they move to their next class.



## ART

This half of term, the children in Year 2 will be looking at art at different 3D forms including making accurate representations of real-life objects, using a range of methods and materials, and evaluating existing 3D art.
